Level: A New Extended Stay Accommodation in Yaletown

Yaletown is all about big egos and little dogs. But peel away the layers of pretentiousness and there's no denying it's packed with some of the city's most innovative and interesting restaurants, lounges, boutiques and spas. What's missing? An equally stylish place to crash. There's a serious dearth of hotel rooms in that forest of glass towers. Our favourite spot (and the original Vancouver design hotel) is the [Opus](#), but its 96 rooms fill up fast. Then there's the problem of what to do if you want to stay longer than a few days. Enter LEVEL Furnished Livings, a new extended stay concept for temporary denizens of Yaletown who don't want to compromise between hotel amenities and condo comfort. We like the idea and we're really impressed that they managed to pick up the area's characteristic contemporary design without going Concord Pacific cookie-cutter. You can rent a studio, a 1-bedroom, 2-bedroom or penthouse suite for a month or more at prices that are actually comparable to apartment rental rates in the area. All 187 furnished suites have fully-equipped kitchens, large living spaces, air conditioning, in-suite laundry and balconies. Plus, the building has a rooftop pool and hot tub, as well as a fitness centre with personal trainers. Prices start at \$3,150/month. stayinglevel.com
